Prospective authors are invited to submit high-quality papers in the above research fields. Papers, with maximum length of six pages, are to be prepared in accordance with the SAUPEC format available on the conference website.

REVIEW POLICY

Full papers submitted in the period **15 October to 30 November** are guaranteed of peer review. Best papers will be submitted to be reviewed for possible publication in a special issue of the SAIEE Africa Research Journal. **Papers received between 1 and 15 December are not guaranteed of peer review, they will be accepted as discussion papers.** Papers accepted by the review panel will be published in the conference proceedings. Papers not accepted by the review panel may be presented as posters, but will not be included in the proceedings. **All papers will be checked for plagiarism and screened accordingly.** The full review policy is available on the conference website.
