1. The Charge Reward Program

1. Aims to increase level of **engagement** of SAIEE members through volunteerism¹

2. Rewards points for qualifying **volunteer** work

3. Allows accumulated **points** to be redeemed for services that ordinarily require payment



1. The Charge Reward Program

Principles:

- 1. Only bona fide² members qualify
- 2. Points will be awarded for SAIEE volunteer work
- 3. The program must not result in *multiple awards* of points for the same effort
- 4. SAIEE employees and Office Bearers will accumulate points for qualifying SAIEE activities done during their official duties
- 5. Points not redeemed within 5 years will expire



1. The Charge Reward Program

¹volunteerism

SAIEE activity where the member is not remunerated in any form by the Institute

²bona fide

Registered as a current member according to the administrative rules of the Institute, e.g. not an applicant, not struck off

This provision applies to a full technical article in line with the theme of the issue. Other contributions, such as a regular non-technical column, will be vetted and awarded points, where necessary, by the T&KL committee

A member shall qualify to claim points for mentoring an individual for 1 hour. This benefit can be claimed more than once

Serving & attending structures of committees (Chapters, Centre Committees, etc)	
Attending a short lecture, webinar, etc (min 1hr)

This includes administrative committees such as Finance and Membership, all Centres and all Sections & Chapters. Governance Committee to vet and award points for new structures that have not yet reached Centre status

Referring any category of new member successfully – to be developed



2. Charge Points Redemption

Redeem against⁸:

ITEM	POINTS
SAIEE full annual membership fee	1500
SAIEE Gala Dinner ticket	500
SAIEE online CPD course/day	1000
Mentoring session (1 hour)	500

⁸Redeem
Other paid events may be added in future



2. Charge Points Awards

Example:

1500 points requires quite an effort. A member, serving on Council (and attending 10 Council meetings), writes a WattNow article, attends 3 flagship events, serves on 2 Council committees (same assumption as Council), presents ½ day lecture and mentors 2 members (1 hour each).

Mentors 2 members	2 x 25	50
½ day lecture/webinar	1 x 25 x 4	100
Flagship events	3 x 25	75
Council committees	2 x 10 x 10	200
Council	10 x 10	100
WattNow	1 x 50	50

2. 'CHARGE' Points Redemption Opportunities

Event	Charge Points Required
Online CPD course (1-day)	1000
Online CPD course (2-day)	2000
Online CPD course (3-day)	3000
Online CPD course (4-day)	4000
Online CPD course (5-day)	5000
Mentoring session (1 hour)	500
Membership fees	1500
Banquet (2 tickets)	500



3. Earning Points/ 'Charge'

Included	Excluded
SAIEE bona fide members only	Non-SAIEE members
Event classified as volunteerism, i.e. no reward in any form	Paid attendance or delivery
Events registered with the SAIEE	Non-SAIEE events
Claim event once only	Double claiming



3. Redeeming points/'Discharge'

Included	Excluded
Redeem against paid events	Cannot redeem points unless they are verified
Redeem in line with points-worth of the event	Cannot redeem points once they expire



4. Terms & Conditions

- 1. The Charge Reward Programme is available to all SAIEE members.
- 2. The reward programme has a 5 year running cycle. Accumulated Charge Reward Points are valid for 5 years, starting 1 December 2019. On 30 November 2024, all accumulated points are reset to 0 and a new 5 year cycle begins.
- 3. It is the members responsibility to ensure that their point accumulation events are captured correctly and provide proof should there be a claim.
- 4. Additional point accumulation and redemption events will be added as time progresses.
- Points awarded during accumulation events and points required during redemption events are subject to change without notice.
